Minutes

- Richard mentioned that this is the last Member Meeting of the year as next month will be the Christmas party. This is also the election and/or affirmation of board members. Richard polled the present members for volunteers but none were offered so the new board will include one new prior volunteer for Secretary, Kathy Adkins. George is vacating that post.
- Mona has photos for the Goldstrom run and information for the Christmas party on the MOOV web page.
- Gerald reported the Treasury currently holds \$1161.00
- Mimi reported the membership total is up to twenty nine.
- Gloria mentioned upcoming events: Harrah's Buffet tomorrow at 6:30 PM, Moovies updated to 11/19 for this month only. The Mazda dealers did not offer support for the Christmas toys for battered children so their will not be a pre event for the Christmas party.
