- When your are out be aware of your surroundings, let people know where you are going and when you’ll be back. Travel with some one.
- You can register all of your items with Serial number at a web site called Leeds on line, and it is free. If some one steals your stuff and they go to another state to pawn it the police will know the minute they put in the serial #. Make copies of everything you have in your purse or wallet. So if stolen you know what you had and can call to cancel. If a man carries a wallet in back pocket put a rubber band around it as this acts as a friction and you will know if some one is trying to get it.
- When at home make it always appear as if some one is there.
- TRUST YOUR 2ND SENSE.
- Dead Bolts make sure 2 to 3 inch screws in wall. Manufactures use ½ to 1 inch, this is a one kick door where 2 to 3 will give you time to react.
- Call 311 if you feel some one in neighborhood you have questions about and don’t feel right about. Police have a FI card and when they check on these people if any thing has happened in this area they can check and see if this person was in the area at the time of the crime, so this helps the police.
