Ted has been in the car at 160 miles per hour and it is very stable. Goes from 0 to 60 in 4.0 seconds. 4 liter V8. They only built these cars for 3 years as to costly and that meant only about 250 were produced. The Cobra's now are like a kit car. You get the body, tires, suspension, paint job. Then it goes to Speedway Classic Cars and they put in engines or your choice along with all that is required for emissions of today.**
  - **Debbie Ogden spoke about being born in 1950 in Atlantic City. When she was 3 she sang on live radio. She also sang for commercials. In 1966 she got very sick. A doctor over heard her parents trying to get Doctors here to operate on her but wouldn't. He took them aside and said he would do it. He was from Austria and as you can see she is with us today. Worked on Tourbin engines. Then went with the company to Boeing then to Panama where they took care of a 727 plane set up for a 2 star general and made ready for him when ever he wanted it. He met Mimi at a volley ball game in Alameda. Where he went to work after the service. They bought a 42 ft Troller after giving up an apartment in the bay area. When they took it out with the dealer, Mimi went down below to clean a little, and when Richard went to check on her she was as sick as a dog. But she over came that and they lived on the boat 4 ½ years. On a Thanksgiving day with friends and family and a minister they took the boat and went out into the San Francisco Bay and got married. In 2006 Richard had a kidney transplant. Between he and Mimi they have 4 kids and 6 grandkids.**
